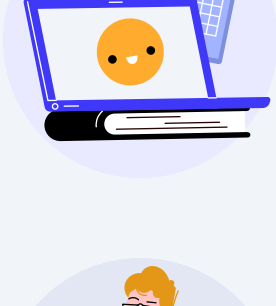




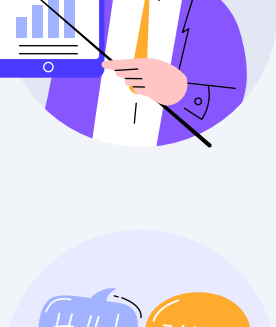
ESSA Federal Funding: A Brief Guide

ESSA focuses on improving the quality of education for all students, especially those from disadvantaged backgrounds. It emphasizes state control and accountability, teacher quality, and support for underprivileged students through various programs.



TITLE I

Provides financial assistance to schools serving many students from low-income families. The aim is to give every child an equal chance to succeed in school and life by offering a quality education. These funds can provide extra instructional materials and resources, teacher professional development, and support for disadvantaged students.



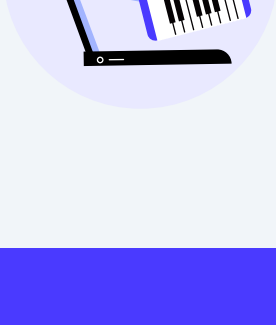
TITLE II

Funds are allocated to promote excellent teaching and leadership in schools and districts. These funds can facilitate professional development opportunities for teachers and leaders.



TITLE III

Funding aims to provide extra resources that enhance the English language proficiency and academic performance of students who are learning English as a second language. This funding can be utilized for supplementary instructional materials or professional development opportunities catering to English learners' needs.



TITLE IV

Is a flexible block grant that can be used to support programs and professional development that address the comprehensive needs of students, including their mental and physical health, safety, and technology-based learning.

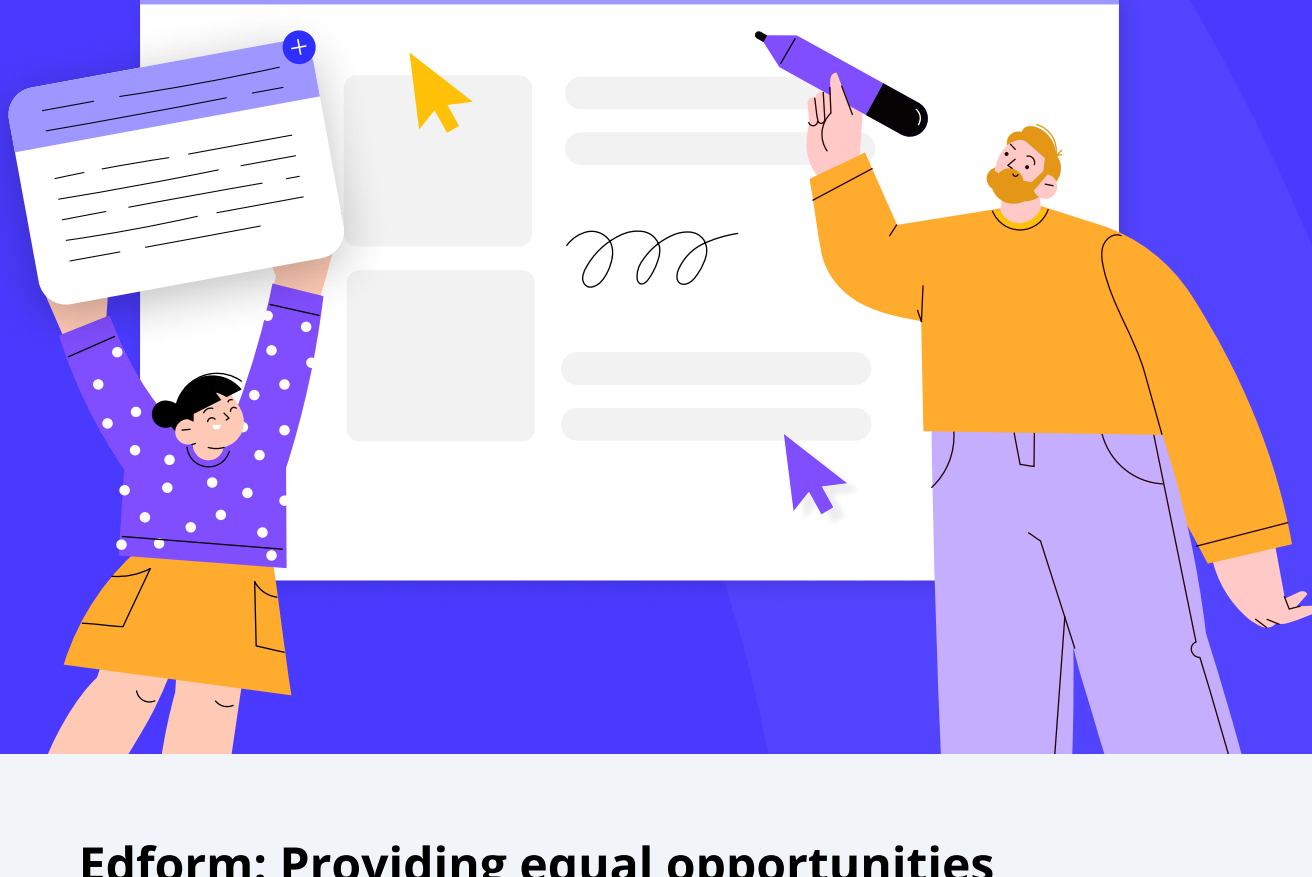

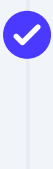

TITLE I. Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged



Student Engagement

Create engaging and interactive instructional materials that support student learning. Create more personalized and targeted learning experiences for students struggling academically.



Parent and Family Engagement

Provide parents and families with access to student progress data and interactive materials to support learning at home. Engage families in their children's education with extensive feedback in text, audio, or video form.



Progress Monitoring

Provide tools for ongoing progress monitoring to ensure that interventions have the desired effect on student learning. Provide real-time data on student progress, and adjust instruction and interventions as needed to support student success.



Data-Driven Decision-Making

Collect and analyze data on student performance to inform instruction and decision-making. Identify areas of need and develop targeted interventions to support student learning.



Reporting and Accountability

Provide schools and districts with detailed reports on student performance and progress and data on how the platform is being used to support instruction.



TITLE II. Supporting Effective Instruction



Professional Development
